HUMANITIES DEGREE TRACK

The newest accelerated program at CCSJ is **Humanities**. This program is being implemented during the Spring 2010 semester. The Humanities degree provides students with a background suitable of future studies in law, business, and the traditional humanistic disciplines. Its emphasis on cultural knowledge, critical thinking, and communication skills will also make it ideal for students seeking personal enrichment or professional career advancement.

This program is set up like the Organization Management degree track. Students will take a series of 14 classes that will meet once per week for 18 months.
