## DID YOU KNOW?

If available, an article will be sent to your school email within a period of seven days.


## AN UPDATE FROM THE BISHOP GRUTKA ARCHIVES

As many of you know, this semester Martin Martinez has been working alongside Brother Jerry to organize, develop, and digitize the many photographs, letters, and personal items of the late Andrew G. Grutka, the first bishop of the Gary Dioceses (1965 to 1984). Among the thousands of interesting artifacts in the collection are images of Bishop Grutka with Pope Paul VI and St. John Paul II, Sen. John F. Kennedy (left picture) and Mayor Richard Daley. When completed, the archive will be an excellent resource for students and scholars to learn about Bishop Grutka and the great work that he did. Martin Martinez has been at CCSJ for over twenty-five years and holds a master's degree in art history.
