

DID YOU KNOW ?

The Specker Library offers instructors the option of scheduling a library instruction session tailored specifically to their course or assignment. Librarians can cover a range of topics, including how to evaluate web resources, find peer-reviewed research articles, and more. In an effort to streamline how the library fulfills certain services, the library has transitioned much of its paperwork to an electronic format, including the forms used to request the placement of books and media on reserve, and requests for library instruction. When instructors visit the library’s website, they will be able to see that the library now has a “Forms” page with links to a “Course Reserve Request” and “Library Instruction Request” form. By clicking on either link, instructors will be taken to an online form where they can submit a detailed request. The library believes that this transition will increase efficiency, improve accessibility, and allow the library to monitor how these services are deliv-
