- * Experience in teaching elementary methods courses, foundations in education courses, implementing Response to Intervention, and building collaborative partnerships;

- * demonstrated experience in working with diverse cultural groups in urban environments and teaching/supervision at the university level;
- * demonstrated experience using state-of-the-art and emerging technologies to enhance learning;
- * a commitment to excellence and innovation in teacher preparation, knowledge of and/or experience with CAEP/SPA standards
- * an emerging research and scholarly publication agenda.
